From its early beginnings as a sparsely settled, agricultural community, Plain Township has grown slowly to become the prosperous urban community of today with over 52,501 residents. The Township has an exclusive contract with the Stark County Sheriff's Department providing the Township with twenty-three Deputies, one Detective and one School Resource Officer. The Township also provides a fleet of sheriff cruisers and two unmarked vehicles.

Plain Township has no income tax, is a Home Rule Township, uses Enterprise Zones, Community Reinvestment Areas that offer tax incentives, and has a strong relationship with Regional Planning and area Development Boards.

Our Township offers high quality safety services responsive to the needs of residents and businesses. Our four fire stations are manned 24 hours a day, 365 days a year with certified Firefighter/Paramedics who are well trained in advanced cardiac life support and basic trauma life support.

Enjoy 102 acres of year-round green space at any one of our three beautiful parks: Al Leno Park, Veterans Park and Diamond Community Park. Our Parks Department serves Plain Township residents by preserving open space, offering programs for Township residents of all ages and creating active and passive recreational experiences. Veterans Park is home to various Veterans Memorials and our new Splash Pad recently opened.

Plain Township has high quality roads and well maintained infrastructures. Our road crews give prompt attention to drainage and flooding problems and winter snow removal. Someone is available 24 hours a day for emergencies that may arise when the Township offices are closed.

Our friendly Zoning Department serves the community by protecting residential standards and property values for Plain Township residents. This ensures that property is in compliance with zoning and nuisance requirements which assures the health and safety of the public and improves the appearance and quality of living conditions in neighborhoods to help maximize property values.
